### Create your own costume.

Over 35 million Halloween costumes are purchased every year, most of which are made with synthetic materials that do not decompose. Save money and create a costume from thrifted clothes or clothes in your wardrobe!



### Reuse decorations.

Buy and use decorations that can be stored and reused year after year, rather than buying new decorations each year.

### Do more with your pumpkins.

1.3 BILLION pounds of pumpkin go to waste after Halloween annually. Instead of throwing away all of the materials, look for recipes and other ways to utilize a pumpkin after you have carved it.



### Skip the plastic candy bag.

Skip the single-use plastic candy bag this year and opt for a reusable tote or bag instead.



### Choose your candy wisely.

Choose candy in more sustainable packaging than plastic, like cardboard and foil, to hand out (Dots, Junior Mints, Mike + Ikes, Milk Duds, Whoppers).
